



Summer Program Details

Outdoor time: Children will spend time outdoors at least once a day. Please send hat, sunscreen and insect repellent for your child.

Food: Please send packed lunch, 2 snacks and water bottles labeled with your child's name. Drinking water refills will be provided.

Extended Care: Before and after care (8:30–9am, 4–5:30pm) is available for an additional fee.

Ratio: Teacher to student ratio is 1:10 or less. Campers will be split into groups of 4-6 based on their skill level Beginner - Advanced.

Price: \$580 for 2-week camp session.

Discounts: Campers enrolled in multiple sessions at the time of registration are eligible for discounts: 10% off 2 sessions, 15% off 3 sessions, 20% off 4 or more sessions. Sibling discounts are available.
